History

The City of Troy maintains 583.71 acres of turf that requires a regular mowing schedule. These locations include Parks, Cemeteries, Detention/Retention Ponds, Fire Stations, City owned vacant property, and other Municipal Facilities.

The locations are divided into different proposals based on mowing frequency.

The scope of work includes all labor, tools, equipment, chemicals, transportation, and landscape maintenance services including mowing for municipal grounds.

 For the first time, the City of Troy listed the possibility of preference for bidding companies that offered alternative energy mowers.

Note that this mowing contract excludes the DDA and the Civic Center Campus, which is held by a separate contractor.

The current contract expired December 31, 2016.

On February 23, 2017, a bid opening was conducted as required by City Charter and Code for Upgrade Landscape Maintenance. The bid was posted on the Michigan Inter-governmental Trade Network (MITN) website; www.mitn.info and was sent to the Troy Chamber of Commerce. Six (6) bid proposals were received. Below is a detailed summary of potential vendors for both bid opportunities:

MITN provides a resourceful online platform to streamline the procurement process, reduce costs, and make it easier and more transparent for vendors to do business with the City of Troy.

Active MITN members with a current membership and paying annual dues receive automatic electronic notification which allows instant access to Bids, RFPS and Quote opportunities with the City.

Active MITN non-paying members are responsible to monitor and check the MITN website for opportunities to do business with the City. Inactive MITN member status can occur when a company does not renew their account upon expiration. Inactive members cannot be notified of solicitations or access any bid information.

After reviewing the bid proposals, Brantley Development LLC of Inkster MI, is the low bidder on Proposals B- Various Locations of Municipal Property, C- I-75 Overpasses, and D- Detention/Retention Pond meeting all specifications and is being recommended to provide all labor, tools, equipment, chemicals, transportation and landscape maintenance services including mowing for three (3) years with the option to renew for two (2) additional years at unit pricing as detailed in the attached bid tabulation. Although

not a requirement or a criteria for preference, it is worth noting that Brantley Development LLC is a minority owned company as noted in its bid proposal.

In addition to the mentioned proposals, City Staff is recommending EQ Grounds LLC of Waterford MI for Proposals A- Parks, Medians, and Municipal Property and Proposal E- Irrigated Athletic Fields. EQ Grounds LLC offers environmentally friendly mowing by using alternative fuels such as propane and commercial grade electric equipment. Implementing a Green Initiative Strategy through the city's mowing operations has an increased cost of 11%-14%. This would save an estimated 10,000 gallons of nonsustainable gas, and would eliminate the equivalent of 846 cars worth of emissions annually. The value added proposal in the bid is being recommended, which is to provide all labor, tools, equipment, chemicals, transportation and landscape maintenance services including mowing for five years at unit pricing as detailed in the attached bid tabulation.

Financial

Funds are available through the Public Works, Streets and Drains and Grounds operating budgets.

In addition, city management recommends awarding a contract for providing Mowing and Landscape Services to EQ Grounds LLC, of Waterford, MI for Proposals A and E, as per unit bid pricing; for an estimated total cost of \$330,978 for 2017, \$336,236 for 2018, and \$341,494 for 2019, 2020, and 2021; not to exceed budgetary limitations at prices contained in the bid tabulation opened February 23, 2017. 

Brantley Development LLC has the financial ability to lease and/or purchase any additional equipment necessary to meet the needs of the City.

Maintenance Plan

Our staff will coordinate with the City of Troy staff to develop a transition plan with dates to ensure none of the maintenance activities are neglected. We will review property maps to ensure all areas of the property are address and discuss any potential past mowing practices.

We will review the list of locations provided by the city and develop a GPS map (See Example Map #1), create a route and a weekly schedules. We will map all locations in Basecamp, a Garmin Software program, which gives us the capability of creating waypoints by address, intersection and manual input. For properties that do not have an address, we will use the closest improved property address as a waypoint. After all locations are inputted into the program as waypoints, then a number of routes can be created based on a predicted number of properties that can be serviced in one day by a two man or more mowing crew. If needed, we have the staff level to dispatch more than one mowing crew to the city.

Once all routes are created, we will upload the routes to a Garmin GPS and assign a list of locations to be serviced to our mowing crews. We will maintain the same routes and approved schedule though out the mowing season. Properties will only be added or deleted on the request from the City of Troy program supervisor.



Our approach to managing the approximately one hundred fifty locations is to service approximately 30 properties a day for the weekly schedule. When the weather is hot and as requested the mowing schedule will be pushed to bi-weekly service. We then would schedule into two weeks, therefore allowing us to maintain approximately 75 lots in the first week and the other 75 properties the following week.

Invoicing

Bi weekly invoices shall be formatted in Microsoft Excel and transmitted electronically to the City. Invoices shall be prepared reflecting the total number of vacant lots and price/cost of maintenance per location. Below is an example of the format that will be used to submit Invoices. All mowing invoices will be forwarded every two weeks after the first round of cuts have been completed until the end of the mowing season
