OBJECTIVE OF RFP:

The objective of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to offer experienced Companies, Firms and/or Artists specializing in Memorial Monument Design an opportunity to submit a detailed proposal. The City of Troy shall consider Proposals that clearly state how the proposed Design Project shall be :

1. Accessible and welcoming to the public
2. An inviting destination where police officers and police personnel, family members and the community are able to honor the City's fallen officers who gave the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
3. A focal point for ceremonies and events; such as the Police Memorial Day Ceremony.
4. A reminder to working police personnel of the ever-present risk associated with their service.
5. A destination for the public to offer expressions of appreciation, sympathy and grief should other officer deaths occur in the future.

PRE-PROPOSAL MEETING – SITE INSPECTION:

All bidders *are encouraged to* examine the Memorial site to review and view the site in accordance with the specifications. A **Pre-Proposal Meeting is scheduled for November 30, 2016, 10:00am, EST.** at the City of Troy City Hall, Conference Room C; 500 West Big Beaver, Troy, MI 48083. An opportunity to inspect the site shall be provided during the pre-proposal meeting.

PROPOSAL SIGNATURES:

Each authorized representative of the Firm must sign the proposal with their usual signature and shall give their full business address. Proposals submitted by partnerships shall be signed with the partnership name by one of the members or by an authorized representative. Proposals by corporations shall be signed with the name of the corporation followed by the signature and designation of the President, Secretary, or other person authorized to bind it in the matter. Each signature represents binding commitment upon the Respondent to provide the services offered to the City if the Respondent is determined to be the most responsive and responsible Respondent.

The purchase order issued in conjunction with the Contract Form from the City of Troy shall create a bilateral Contract between the parties, and the successful bidder shall commit to perform the Contract in accordance with the Specifications and Scope of Work.

COMPLETION DATE: A work schedule shall be provided to the Troy Police Department and approved prior to the start of work.

The project must be completed by the dates stated in the Scope of Work.

PROGRESS PAYMENTS:

Partial payments shall be made at the discretion of the designated City Representative. The City of Troy reserves the right to withhold payments until acceptance for that portion of work completed which is being invoiced.

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MICHIGAN CONSTRUCTION LIEN ACT:

The bidder agrees that, if awarded the Contract he/she shall abide by all requirements of the Michigan Construction Lien Act (P.A. 1980, No. 497) as amended and effective March 1, 1982, and to provide full and complete Sworn Statements on Owner-approved forms.

PUBLIC ACT 57:

Public Act 57 requires contractors to provide certain notices to governmental entities concerning improvements on real property; to allow for modifications of contracts for improvement of real property; to provide for remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts. 

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

Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution 8: Best Value Award – Police Memorial Project

History

The Troy Police Honor Guard was formed to perform official remembrance ceremonies and funeral details for law enforcement professionals who have passed away in the line of duty. The Honor Guard also performs flag raising duties at various civic events that require a dignified display and presentation of our nation's flag. The Honor Guard is highly trained in the aspects of drill and ceremony, flag presentations, and funeral details.

The Troy Police Honor Guard Inc. is a 501c3 charity founded to give financial support to the families of law enforcement professionals in the State of Michigan who have passed away in the line of duty. They also fund projects and participate in ceremonies that memorialize law enforcement professionals. In support of these efforts the Troy Police Honor Guard participates in various fundraising initiatives.

The Troy Police Honor Guard has proposed to have a badge monument erected in front of the Police Department as a standing Memorial to all Law Enforcement Officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty. This monument will serve as a lasting symbol of the service and sacrifice of all Law Enforcement Officers, past, present and future and exemplify our core values of Integrity, Respect, Laws and the Constitution, Accountability, Problem Solving and Professionalism.

The Badge Monument project is estimated to cost approximately \$100,000.00. The Troy Police Honor Guard has conducted several fundraising activities to support this project and to date has raised approximately \$62,000.00.

Purchasing

On January 5, 2017, a bid opening was conducted as required by City Charter and Code for the Police Memorial Project. The bid was posted on the Michigan inter-Governmental Trade Network (MITN) website; www.mitn.info. Four (4) proposals were received. Below is a detailed summary of potential vendors:

 - A. Experience and knowledge of Police Memorial Design Projects
 - B. Positive References
 - D. Qualifications of firm to perform the project as specified
 - E. Work plan and methodology proposed
 - E. Questionnaire Responses

- Scoring criteria was as follows:
 - 40% Proposal Score (100 point base)
 - 45% Price Score (100 point base)
 - 15% Interview Score (100 point base)

- Five (5) Committee Members reviewed and evaluated the proposals. The Committee Members were as follows:
 - Lieutenant. Russell Harden
 - Sergeant. Andy Satterfield

- Based on the Firms' qualifying conditions and scores for proposal and price; the top three (3) Firms were interviewed by the full committee on March 30, 2017.

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Financial

Approximate cost is \$100,000.00 which will be 100% funded by donations and fundraising activities through the efforts of the Troy Police Honor Guard. To date, \$62,000.00 has been raised to fund the Police Memorial Project. Fundraising efforts are ongoing.

Recommendation

City management recommends awarding a contract to design, construct, and install a Police Memorial for the City of Troy Police Department, to the highest rated proposer, *Eagle Sign & Design of New Albany, IN* as a result of a best value evaluation process for a total not to exceed amount of \$100,000.00 at prices contained in the bid tabulation opened January 5, 2017. The award is contingent upon the Firm's submission of properly executed bid documents including insurance certificates and all specified requirements.
