Regular Business:

Tom Darling introduced Jeffrey Tebeau, the Chief Actuary from Gabriel, Roeder, Smith & Co. Mr. Tebeau presented the VFIP Actuarial Valuation Report for period ended December 31, 2016. As our actuary, he assesses the plan every year and comes up with a contribution rate that is sufficient to fund the plan. He went over the numbers in the actuarial report and highlighted the city's contribution computed for 2018 and 2019. He indicated to the Board that the plan is 50.1% funded, the rate of return assumption of 6.5% is on the conservative side compared to other systems and the fiscal 2019 annual required contribution is \$1,282,259.

Amy Cole gave a presentation of the 2017 second quarter performance reports. She discussed the movement from slow performing bonds to more equity allocation.

Bob Altai discussed the market performance in light of the current presidential policies and holds the view that at this time the bull market is doing really well. He feels there are no indicators that show any imminent crash in the market.

Tom Darling briefly reviewed the assets, liabilities, total additions, total benefits paid and the net increase in net position as of June 30, 2017.
