Left Turn Prohibition at Big Beaver/Crooks

In December, 1981, the Oakland County Board of Road Commissioners approved a Traffic Control Order prohibiting left turns at the Big Beaver/Crooks intersection. The order did, however, permit buses to make direct left turns from Northbound Crooks and from Westbound Big Beaver. The permitted left turns for buses provided a convenience for buses traveling to an from SEMTA terminal on Barrett Streeet, which has access to Crooks South of Big Beaver at Maplelawn.

Recently, the Troy City Council has expressed concern about the safety of these left turn movements by SEMTA buses. The City Council has asked the Traffic Committee to consider whether the City of Troy should request that the Oakland County Road Commission prohibit these left turns by buses.

The Oakland County Road Commission has not found left turns by buses at this location or other locations in Oakland County (such as Woodward Ave.) to be an accident problem. Because buses are large objects they tend to be avoided by other motorists. If buses were compelled to turn through median crossovers, East and West of Crooks Road, we might find additional ruts behind the curb at these locations.

SUGGESTED RESOLUTIONS

- A. Recommend that Oakland County Road Commission Traffic Control Order No. TP68-22-81, Revision No. 1 be changed to include buses in the left turn prohibition for Northbound Crooks and Westbound Big Beaver.
- B. Recommend that no change be made in Oakland County Road Commission Traffic Control Order No. TP68-22-81, Revision No. 1.
