A. Proposed Brownfield Redevelopment Plan #8 – Somerset Shoppes, LLC, 2830 W. Maple Road

Mark F. Miller provided an overview of the proposed project. Elizabeth Masserang, Mike Kulka, Jordan Jonna and Jason Gekiere provided additional project details.

Redevelopment entails the demolition of the current office building, which is dilapidated, and for the expansion of the current shopping center (approximately 14,000 s.f.). The redevelopment will also entail the construction of two outlot buildings to support additional commercial/retail tenants at the center (totaling approximately 5,100 s.f. and 11,700 s.f.). Furthermore, the developer is anticipated to install an underground storm water detention system. The estimated capital investment is \$5.4 million.

Eligible activities include Baseline Environmental Assessments, Due Care Activities, Demolition, Asbestos Activities, and Brownfield Plan Preparation. Developer reimbursable costs total approximately \$1,098,441.
