### 3.) Regular Business

# A. 2019 International Day Follow-Up

Committee Member Bica-Grodsky introduced the topic, and highlighted the report that she wrote for the group regarding International Day 2019. She highlighted the positives, which included a great turnout from the participants in the event, as well as the improved stage, and the significant contributions from various members of the committee.

Bica-Grodsky also highlighted some of the challenges of the event, which include issues with the Troy Community Foundation's communication with the International Day Subcommittee that resulted in issues with performances, a lack of participation from members of the Global Troy Advisory Committee in the event, and the limited promotion of the event.

#### B. Next Steps for the GTAC in 2019

The group decided to continue this discussion at the next meeting, and come back with ideas as to how to advise City Council about their future.
