DEAR SIRs:

I was employed by the City of Troy Police Dept. as a Police Cadet and Police Service Aide from September 1974 until October 1977. I terminated my employment with the city in October 1977 and was paid the amount I had contributed to the Employee Pension Fund. I was re-employed with the Troy Police Dept. as a Patrolman some eleven months later on September 5, 1978, and am currently employed as such.

Upon re-employment I was not notified in any manner that I had the opportunity pay back to the Pension Fund the amount I had been reimbursed in order to acquire my previous three years seniority with the city. At this time I would petition The Pension Board to allow me the opportunity to acquire the seniority time I previously served with the city by repayment to the Pension Fund of the dollar amount I was previously reimbursed.

Again I would stress that it was only recently that I became aware that there was a policy upon re-employment to obtain previous seniority, and had I known at the time I was re-employed I would have done so at that time.
