6. <u>Install Traffic Signal at Rochester and Rankin</u>

Pam Kareta, of Classic Companies, reports that employees of businesses on Gable have a difficult time exiting Rankin and Gable and that there have been accidents in the area. There is a bar on the northeast corner of the intersection and a school bus stop on the southwest corner.

Signal warrant studies indicate that there were nine crashes in 1995 that may have been correctable by a traffic signal (six left-turn-related and three rear end crashes),

four of which were injury accidents. The average speed on Rochester Road was found to be 47 mph, though the posted speed limit is 35 mph.

Warrant 5 - Progressive Movement, Warrant 9 - Four-hour Volumes, and Warrant 11 - Peak Hour Volume warrants were satisfied. From the warrant study, it can be seen that installation of a signal at Rochester and Rankin may alleviate some traffic crash problems and access problems for vehicles on Rankin. However, this signal may add to traffic congestion on Rochester Road, if not coordinated with adjacent signals.

Ms. Kareta presented petitions from approximately 355 people who work in the area, requesting a traffic signal. She pointed out that Livernois has three signals between 14 Mile and Maple, while Rochester Road only has one.

Ken Kareta, owner of Classic Companies, also pointed out the need for the traffic signal. He believes there is more traffic on Rankin than on Elmwood. Many motorists use Rankin to cut through to Stephenson and I-75.

Mr. Halsey suggested that the light need not be fully operational 24 hours a day and weekends. Mr. Abraham said that Troy has 14 or 15 traffic signals that flash during off hours. This section of Rochester Road is City-owned, therefore, the county may approve the signal.

4. Recommend that City Council amend Traffic Control Order #97-1-SS. Resolution #97-81, to add "Stop" sign on Gresham at Lexington

At the February 3, 1997, City Council meeting, Resolution #97-81 provided for installation of "Stop" signs on Lexington at Gresham and removal of the "Yield" sign on Gresham at Lexington. This removes all traffic controls from the Gresham approach to the intersection. The Traffic Engineer recommended installing a stop sign on the Gresham approach to create an all-way stop at the intersection.

On March 19, 1997, the Traffic Committee recommended that Traffic Control Order 97-1-SS be amended to provide for the addition of a stop sign on Gresham at Lexington. On March 31, 1997, City Council referred this item back to the Traffic Committee, since some Council members received phone calls from a resident of Somerset North subdivision opposing the resolution to install stop signs. The Traffic Engineering office received a communication on April 8, 1997, indicating that this issue was voted on at their homeowners' association meeting and that a majority of the residents want the stop sign. Therefore, it is recommended that the previous recommendation be forwarded to the City Council again.

Mr. Diefenbaker was opposed to this motion, as he felt the Traffic Committee should stick by its original recommendation for no stop signs, based on traffic counts and speed surveys.

5. <u>Install Speed Bumps on Baker Court</u>

Tammy Cheslock reported a problem with speeding on Baker Court, a dead end street. In spite of the "Dead End" warning sign at the entrance, motorists enter Baker Court thinking it connects to Rochester Road. They turn around and exit at high speeds. Mr. Abraham observed the area and found a low volume of traffic during the school rush hour. A traffic count found the daily volume to be 89 cars, with an average speed of 24 mph. When Mr. Abraham informed Ms. Cheslock of the disadvantages of speed bumps, and that warrants were not met, she requested "Children at Play" signs.

Mike Morton, of 1135 Baker Court, told the Committee that there are 24 homes with 19 children under age 5 in the neighborhood, and there is also a day care provider. Sgt. Swanson said that often the parents dropping children at day care are in a hurry to get to work and drive too fast. He suggested that the day care provider warn her clients about observing the speed limit.

Mr. Cotsonika questioned whether motorists will notice a "Children at Play" sign if they don't see the existing "Dead End" sign. Mr. Halsey felt that "Children at Play" signs might give residents a false sense of security.

Mr. Halsey pointed out that many times speeders are found to be residents of the neighborhood. Ms. Hubbell suggested that residents get license plate numbers of the offenders and report them to the Traffic Safety Unit for follow-up.

Recommend posting one additional "Dead End" and two new "No Outlet" signs on either side of Baker Court at Boyd, so that there would be one of each sign on each side.

Discussion followed, and Mr. Abraham indicated that it is not standard practice to have two signs on one single pole. Four signs at the entrance to Baker Court would create a "visual clutter," therefore, he recommended only one sign on each corner.

Mr. Palchesko said that eastbound Square Lake also backs up at Rochester. Mr. Abraham said that the Road Commission for Oakland County is monitoring that area and will report back to him.

Ms. Perry said that the south side Athens High School needs more fire lane signs. Students receiving tickets for parking in the fire lane claim it is not posted. Lt. Matlick said that the school has been asked to put up more signs but hasn't yet done so.

Lt. Matlick stated that Oakland-Troy Airport wants to post "No Stopping, Standing, Parking, Fire Lane, Tow Away Zone" signs in front of their terminal.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

First I would like to thank Mr. Abrahams and his staff for all of their hard work in helping us achieve our goal of obtaining a traffic signal at one of these busy intersections, Rochester and Gable or Rochester and Elmwood. Mr. Abrahams has been very pleasant to work with, and I appreciate the fact that he has worked diligently on this.

Today I am here to represent the companies and people who could not be present.

We have needed a light on Rochester Road to help people slow down, and better regulate the heavy traffic flow for years.

The speed limit is 35mph, but people go about 60!

There is a children's bus stop on the corner of Gable (across from Rankin) and Rochester Rd. with a popular bar, Corradi's, across from the bus stop. The bus stop is on the S.W. corner, and the bar is on the S.E. corner.

There is no center turn lane on Rochester Road between !5 and 14 Mile Roads, so people coming out of Gable and Rankin are fighting one another to make it safely across the street. (That may be why Troy Collision is located on the N.E. corner of Rankin and Rochester Rd.)

Speaking of Troy Collision, the owner, Mike, told me that he tried to get a light about a year ago, and he was told that usually they won't put in a light until there's a fatality. well, there just might be one! I can't understand why a collision shop would want to help prevent cars from getting in accidents, when they receive all of the business, unless it was a very dangerous intersection, don't you think?

Rankin is a main road which takes you out to Stephenson Hwy, and then out to I-75 highway entrance ramps by Rochester Rd Entrance and the 14 Mile Rd Entrance ramps.

There are approximately 80 companies in the area that would utilize the light every day, not to mention the thousands of city residents. I'm sure there are more people in these companies than even in the residential area, and the residents already have one light at Goodale.

The tax money with which the companies on Rankin and Elmwood have paid over the last 20 years have more than paid for this traffic signal 10 times over. Companies like The Classic Companies, D&S Engine, Troy Collision, Drake Hydraulic Systems, Inc., Crane Technologies Group, Inc., Future Products, Corp., Bosco, C.S.I., G.A. Frisch, Inc., Apollo Trick Titanium, Time Auto Transport, Magnetool, and J&M Reproduction all signed the petition,

even Corradi's posted it and received signatures from their customers. There's also a church down Elmwood that could use the light, and apartment complexes.

For heaven's sake, we even have geese walking across Rochester Road at the Gable / Rankin intersection. Maybe once Mother Goose is hit, this will count as a fatality.

No but seriously, our employees have been involved in accidents, and our customers would like a light as well. We only have a 42 minute lunch our but 1/6 of the time is spent at the intersections waiting to make a turn at lunch!

Leaving for the end of the day is a whole other story, people wait and wait at these roads to safely pull out into traffic, only to have someone flying at you from both sides with no where to go because there's no center turning lane!

We also get tons of semi trucks delivering down Gable Rd, as a matter of fact one of the accidents with our employee involved a semi, and happened right at the children's bus stop a few months ago.

A women at the Bosco company told me she probably calls 911 two or three times a day!

I also heard from a gentleman at D&S Engine that they tried a petition for a light 6 years ago, and sent it to Clawson and Troy, but nothing was done about it, and they had over 1700 signatures.

The point is, Livernois has three lights between 15 and 14 Mile Roads, and Rochester only has one! Everyone cuts through Elmwood to get to the highway, but there is no light.

The three (3) lights on Livernois from 15 Mile Rd (Maple), are at .3 miles, .5 miles, and .8 miles distance to other lights. Between the first and second light is a distance of .3 miles, the second and third is .2miles, the third and fourth is .3 and the fourth and last light on 14 Mile Rd. is .2 miles.

On Rochester Rd., there is only one light which is at .7 miles from 15 Mile Rd.

So if there was a light at Rankin, it will be ONLY.3.5 miles from 15 Mile Rd., and.3.5 miles from the next light (Goodale). Or if you even put a light on Elmwood, the light would still be at .5 miles from 15 Mile, and .2miles away from Goodale which still wouldn't be a bad idea, because the lights between Park and Elmwood off Livernois are .2miles apart, so as you can see this is not an unrealistic request!

Please take all of the above into consideration. We would not want the Troy Traffic Committee to be responsible for any accidents or fatalities which may continue to occur at these extremely busy intersections due to the result of a lack of action on their part; given the fact they have been made aware of the problem many times, and it is now hopefully on public record.



The annual meeting of the Somerset North Homeowners Association was held last evening, April 7, 1997. With 40-50 homeowners in attendance in addition to the entire board, the issues of the proposed 3-way stop at the intersection of Lexington and Gresham were addressed. Following clearly defined rules of order in accordance with the SNHA by-laws, a vote was taken to determine whether or not stop signs should be installed here. The vote was unanimous among the membership in support of the signs with several board members (including Barb Wacker and myself) abstaining. I therefore stand by my contention that, as the City Liaison for the SNHA, I was speaking on behalf of the vast majority of homeowners in Somerset North in my presentations to the Traffic Committee and the City Council.




