How many lane miles of mill and replacement will be completed in this project? What exactly does complete removal and replacement of failed pavement areas mean in this context? How many lane miles of that will likely be completed?

Answer: Scott Finlay – City Engineer

This project will mill and resurface 5.43 miles of local roads, which equates to 10.86 lane miles. After the pavement is milled, any badly deteriorated areas (base failures) are removed and replaced with new base material. Less than 1 percent of the pavement is estimated for base repairs for this project.
