 - A. <u>VARIANCE REQUEST</u>, 2143 ALFRED, TYLER HIJAZI This property is located within the R-1D zoning district which requires a front yard setback of 25 feet along Alfred. The zoning ordinance limits fence height to 30 inches (2.5 feet) within a front yard setback. The petitioner is seeking a fence height variance for the installation of a proposed new wood and mesh "Deer" fence which would be 6 feet in height and placed 1 foot away from the Alfred property line. The fence is proposed to run 30 feet along Alfred and return 24 feet back toward the house for a total variance length of 6 feet high wood and mesh "Deer" fence of 54 feet in the Alfred required front yard. CHAPTER 83 FENCE CODE

B. VARIANCE REQUEST, 5027 SHADY CREEK, ASHLEY NARAYANAN - This property consists of a corner lot. According to the City of Troy Zoning Ordinance, it qualifies as a corner lot with front lot lines along both Shady Creek and E. Long Lake. The property is located within the R-1B zoning district which requires a front yard setback of 40 feet, along both Shady Creek and E. Long Lake, where the zoning ordinance limits fence height in the front yard to 30 inches (2.5 feet). The petitioner is seeking a fence height variance for the installation of a 6 feet high, vinyl, privacy fence. The fence is proposed to run 72 feet along E. Long Lake and return 11.5 feet to the south face of the house for a total variance length of 6 feet high vinyl privacy fence of 83.5 feet in the E. Long Lake designated front yard. Of the total 163.8 feet of fence requested, 80.3 feet of the fence complies with zoning regulations and does not require a variance.

3. HEARING OF CASES

A. <u>VARIANCE REQUEST</u>, 2143 ALFRED, TYLER HIJAZI – This property is located within the R-1D zoning district which requires a front yard setback of 25 feet along Alfred. The zoning ordinance limits fence height to 30 inches (2.5 feet) within a front yard setback. The petitioner is seeking a fence height variance for the installation of a proposed new wood and mesh "Deer" fence which would be 6 feet in height and placed 1 foot away from the Alfred property line. The fence is proposed to run 30 feet along Alfred and return 24 feet back toward the house for a total variance length of 6 feet high wood and mesh "Deer" fence of 54 feet in the Alfred required front yard. Of the total 91 feet of fence requested, 37 feet of the fence complies with zoning regulations and does not require a variance. *CHAPTER 83 FENCE CODE*

Mr. Abate read the variance request narrative. He stated the property was cited with an enforcement, EN2025-0058 Working Without a Permit.

Chair Abitheira advised the petitioner that three votes are required for approval and that a postponement of the item could be requested until a full Board is present.

The petitioner Tyler Hijazi requested a postponement.

MOTION CARRIED

B. VARIANCE REQUEST, 4819 ROCHESTER, KIM ALLARD for ALLIED SIGNS – The petitioner requests a sign area variance to install a replacement 56.25 square foot ground sign set back 12 feet from the planned or future right of way line, whichever is greater, where the Sign Ordinance requires the sign be no larger than 50 square feet. In order to grant a variance, the Board must find that all five appeals criteria of Chapter 85 Signs, Section 85.01.08, B, 1, are met. CHAPTER 85 SIGN CODE

Mr. Abate read the variance request narrative. He reminded the Board members that all five appeals criteria of Chapter 85 Signs must be met to grant a variance. Mr. Abate stated the former 135 square foot sign had to be removed because of the widening of Rochester Road. Mr. Abate said placing a sign on the lot line is not an option because of a 12 foot easement. He said the department received no communications in response to the public notice.

Present were Bob Bongiorno of McDonald's and Attorney Jerry Pesick.

Chair Abitheira advised the petitioner that three votes are required for approval and that a postponement of the item could be requested until a full Board is present.

Mr. Bongiorno asked to go forward with the request. He said McDonald's at their expense removed the former sign due to eminent domain. Mr. Bongiorno addressed the size and setback of the proposed new sign. He said the former sign was a larger digital sign.

Mr. Pesick said the City requested removal of the former sign by July 31, 2025. He said McDonald's is at no fault and acted in good faith. Mr. Pesick stated the proposed sign is a precast mold monument sign of the McDonald brand. He said this McDonald's location has less exposure compared to other McDonald's locations and there was a loss of 40% in sales since the removal of the sign.

Some comments during discussion related to the following:

- Information and pictures submitted with the request.
- Size and type of proposed sign compared to former sign.
- Sign type; ground monument precast mold McDonald brand, no digital, not aerial, height complies.
- Hardship placed on the petitioner.
- Existing utility easements appear not to obstruct the sign placement.
- Effect of the Rochester Road widening and potential hardship on businesses.
- Sign Ordinance size limitation to 50 square feet.
- Landscaping; no additional landscaping is proposed nor is it required.
- Illumination of sign if any require compliance with the Zoning Ordinance.

Mr. Dziurman said he finds, from the perspective of the Zoning Ordinance, the only hardship is the petitioner's request to install a McDonald's brand sign, and the petitioner could install a sign that meets the size requirements of the Zoning Ordinance.

Mr. Huerta stated the purpose of this Board is making decisions beyond the Zoning Ordinance requirements.

Ms. Brooks said the Board could very well be setting a precedent with its decision today because other businesses might come before this Board requesting variances related to the eminent domain. She said the request for an additional seven (7) square feet is not excessive and it could provide more visibility for McDonald's at this location and boost its sales.

Chair Abitheira finds the petitioner has a solid hardship because the City is taking its property. He said a sign with less square footage and no digital components could be considered more appealing. Chair Abitheira said McDonald's action to remove its sign and comply with the City request reveals its intent to be a good neighbor.

Chair Abitheira opened the Public Hearing. Acknowledging there was no one present who wished to speak, Chair Abitheira closed the Public Hearing.

After a brief discussion with Mr. Pesick, Mr. Bongiorno asked to go forward with a vote. Mr. Bongiorno said he believes it is in the best interest of the City to work with McDonald's and other businesses that might be affected by the eminent domain.

RESOLVED, That a sign ordinance variance request for 4819 Rochester be **granted**, for the following reasons:

1. Exceptional characteristics of the property for which the variance is sought make compliance with the requirements difficult because the road expansion project has put this property into a unique situation.

- 2. The characteristics which make compliance with the requirements of this Chapter difficult are related to the eminent domain and the situation it created.
- 3. The characteristics which make compliance with the requirements of this Chapter difficult are not of a personal nature. The property owner did not create the situation.
- 4. The characteristics which make compliance with the requirements of this Chapter difficult was not created by the owner, a previous owner, or the applicant, as previously stated. The road expansion project is not the doing of the applicant.
- 5. The proposed variance will not be harmful or alter the essential character of the area in which the property is located, and the proposed variance will not affect any of the area by replacing a pole sign. The applicant is creating a good environment.

Application Requirements for 2143 Alfred Dr. deer fence appeal Tyler Hijazi 330-937-2595

Description of Request-

- ► As the homeowner of 2143 Alfred Dr. I am requesting that I be approved to have a 6 foot deer fence around a potager garden to the side of my home.
- ► Construction materials include pressure treated lumber, cedar stain, quickrete, gravel, hog wire fencing, solar light caps, nails.
- ► Method of Construction- the fence was constructed by digging holes with an auger, placing 8 ft 4x4's in the hole, adding gravel for drainage, mixing quikrete, and allowing the poles to set. Afterward the wire fencing was unrolled and nailed to the posts before being topped off with decorative solar light caps. I would also like to add decorative corbels for charm and appeal.
- ► A decorative gate will be added to ensure the deer remain outside the garden

Deer Fence-

- -According to the https://troymi.gov/departments/code_enforcement/wildlife.php website, homeowners are to "Construct fences or put wiring around gardens or individual plants to protect from damage."
- The garden had to be placed here because the natural slope of the land will allow for rain water collection with subsequent gravity drainage into the garden to reduce water waste. There is also no appropriate space in the backyard because there are too many trees blocking the light and space from being used for gardening. The other side of the yard is occupied by a pool and is also not an option.

The fence is see-through and not a privacy fence in anyway.

The characteristics which make compliance with the requirements of the chapter difficult include-

- The fence will not be harmful or alter the essential character of the area, and in fact will improve the curb appeal
- ► Will not impair adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property. The adjacent property owner is a Troy Police officer and he has expressed full support of the project
- ► Will not affect street congestion in anyway
- Will not increase the danger of fire or public safety
- Will not diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area. The neighborhood has expressed their support and excitement for the garden, and have stated the fence is nice looking and does not bother them in anyway.

Monarch Butterfly Habitat-

Monarch butterflies migrate through Michigan, where they will spend their summer One of my goals for the garden is to have a certified butterfly garden through the North American Butterfly Organization

City of Troy Fence Permit Application-

- According to the fence permit for the city of Troy-
- I have submitted a site plan accurate to scale, with distances and lot lines
- The fence is 6 feet or under
- There will be a gate for fire exit
- It is not in an easement zone
- ► There is no HOA in this side of the neighborhood, and in fact many of my approval signatures come from the other side of the street, which is an HOA neighborhood

Petition of Approval-

All of these signatures are from my neighborhood, including those in direct view on my home. They have all either stated that they like the project and are excited to watch it unfold, or don't mind it because I own my home and they don't see a problem with it. I can get more signatures by the time my hearing takes place as well. As of right now there are 36 signatures.

- Final lot grade shall be approved before a fence permit is issued.
- Fences under seven feet do not fall under the 2015 Michigan Building Code.
- Residential Fences cannot exceed 6 feet in height.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- It is <u>highly recommended</u> that the applicant and/or the owner hire a licensed Professional Surveyor for the proper placement of the fence.

- · All disputes among property owners regarding the placement of a fence are a civil matter
- The City of Troy will not be inspecting for placement and the Plan Review executed by any or all staff member of the City of Troy will only be approving or disapproving based on the information submitted by the applicant and it will be limited to what is allowed to be installed per the Zoning Ordinance and City Codes.
- Fences 7 feet tall or over fall under the 2015 Michigan Building Code. A building permit will be required and permit review
 will be performed by the Building Department and the Planning Department.

Dear Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals,

I am requesting a variance to install a fence that would encroach 11.5 feet into the required 40-foot front setback, resulting in an effective setback of 28.5 feet along the side of my home. While the fence complies with Chapter 83 – Fences in terms of height and materials, its placement is restricted by the setback requirement.

This variance is necessary due to practical difficulties related to the unique layout of the lot and the needs of our household:

- 1. Safety for children: We have a one-year-old and a newborn (born 8/18/2025). The fence is necessary to create a secure, fully enclosed yard where they can play safely, protected from street traffic and public access.
- Exercise and containment for pets: We have two dogs one 80 lb and one 10 lb
 — that require sufficient space to run, exercise, and move freely. Without this
 portion of the fence, a significant part of the yard would remain unenclosed and
 unsafe for our pets.
- 3. Privacy: The fence placement provides screening from the street and neighbors, allowing our young children to play outdoors safely while maintaining family privacy.
- 4. Noise reduction: The fence will act as a sound barrier from traffic on E Long Lake Road, reducing noise intrusion into our backyard and improving the overall living environment for our family.

The proposed fence is designed to respect the intent of Chapter 83, maintaining safe sightlines where necessary, using acceptable ornamental materials, and not obstructing any public right-of-way or easements.

Given the lot configuration and family needs, the requested variance is the minimum necessary relief to allow practical use of the yard while still adhering to the intent of the ordinance. The fence will enhance safety, security, privacy, and quality of life for our children and pets, without negatively affecting the surrounding neighborhood.
