History

- The Streets and Drains Division routinely patches potholes in Troy's roadways in an effort to provide safe passage for residents, workers and visitors that travel through Troy every day.
- The City currently owns two (2) hot box type asphalt patchers.
- One of the patchers has reached the end of its service life and will be traded in in order to purchase a newer replacement model.
