The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a pre-hearing to consider DTE Electric Company's May 28, 2021 application for an administrative determination regarding the proper classification of a 120kV single-circuit radial line and associated equipment ("Croswell Interconnection"), running approximately 7.5 miles from an existing International Transmission Company, LLC, dba ITC Transmission "ITCT" substation to a proposed new substation to be built by the City of Croswell, Michigan "Croswell" as distribution under the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's "FERC" seven-factor test for classifying a facility as transmission or distribution.
