Subject:	Repurposing of the Game Room at the Community Center

The Game and Teen Rooms were both included when the Community Center was built in 2001. The Teen Room was later closed due to vandalism and was repurposed for camps and senior groups.

The Game Room consisted of 3 pool tables and 2 ping pong tables. Those tables were beyond repair and were auctioned off on GovDeals.com following City Policy. When deciding how to handle the room going forward the below were considered:

- Price to replace tables would be approximately \$20,000.
- Tables get destroyed, holes in walls, floor left a mess from kids using it. Kids were required to have an adult 18 and older in the room with them, however, the room is not continuously monitored.
- Limited usage during the day.
- The room could be used on weekends as a designated birthday party room, in the summer for day camps, and the rest of the year for senior groups.
- Using this room for senior groups and day camps will allow the banquet rooms to stay available for rentals and increased revenue.

Recreation Staff has concluded that repurposing the room for birthday parties, camps, and senior groups is the best use of this room going forward.
