Subject: Assessment of Delinquent Accounts

History

Section 1.167 of Chapter 5 and Section 6 of Chapter 20 of the Ordinance Code of the City of Troy
require that delinquent payments and invoices, as of April 1st each year, shall be reported to City
Council. City Council shall certify the list to the City Assessor who shall add the delinquent amounts
to the summer tax roll.

<u>Financial</u>

 The delinquent invoices and water/sewer bills to be assessed on the 2022 summer tax roll is as follows:
