
The Challenge:

About This Presentation

- Unlike the federal government, the City cannot spend more money than it has so revenues constrain expenditures.
- Keep in mind City Council can reallocate resources but only voters can increase revenues because the Headlee Amendment requires voters to approve any local property tax increases or new property taxes.
- In other words, City Council can modify pie pieces but only voters can "order" a larger pie.






Troy Recreation and Culture Expenses




Troy General Government Expenses




Troy Public Works Expenses





Expenditures per Capita, 2004












Public Works Expenditures per Capita



Expenditures per Capita, 2021 Excluding Royal Oak




Public Safety Expenditures per Capita


