Italia did not successfully complete the assigned target area. Additionally, the company was unresponsive to several irrigation and private property damage concerns causing the City of Troy to use its resources to complete the repairs.

-J-4b: when is the work expected to be performed for all 3 sites?

The construction schedule will be established once the contract is awarded. The specification requires the contractor to be complete by November 15, 2022. Work will be closely coordinated with activities at each facility to limit the disruption the construction will cause.
