- Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution 4: Oakland County Cooperative Purchasing Contract Water Slide Support Structure Painting at Troy Family Aquatic Center

<u>History</u>

- The Aquatic Center was constructed in 1992 and is approaching 31 years old.
- The support structures of the water slides were last painted in 2016 and require painting as part of routine maintenance.
- Painting of the water slides support structure will be completed in conjunction with the reconditioning of the water slide flumes.
- Water slide support structures require routine maintenance to be in compliance with the State of Michigan. During the 2022 season, the excessive rusting was noted by the inspector as needing to be remedied prior to the opening of the 2023 season.

Purchasing

Pricing to provide labor, materials, and equipment for the painting of the water slides support structures at the Troy Family Aquatic Center has been secured from *National Restoration Inc. of Milford, MI* for an estimated cost of \$29,800.00 as detailed in the attached proposal and as per the Oakland County Purchasing Cooperative Contract #005106/006325. City Council authorized participation in the Cooperative Purchasing Program on November 14, 2022 (Resolution #2022-11-157).

Financial

The funds are budgeted and available in the Troy Family Aquatic Center General Equipment Capital Fund under Project Number 2023C0089. Expenditures will be charged to Account Number 587.789.7978.010.

Recommendation

City Management recommends, that in the best interest of the City, the formal bid process be waived and a contract be awarded to *National Restoration Inc. of Milford, MI* for the painting of the water slide support structures located at the Troy Family Aquatic Center for an estimated total amount of \$29,800 as detailed in the attached proposal and per the Oakland County Purchasing Cooperative Contract #005106/006325. The award is contingent upon the contractor's submission of properly executed insurance documents and all other specified requirements.

RE: Repainting of the Steel Slide Supports

Mr. Lagarde,

Per our onsite meeting, we are proposing to provide, all material, labor and equipment needed to complete the following items of work.

Scope of Work:

- Mobilize
- With the use of ladders and scaffolding access the supports for the water slides.
- Provide protection of the slides in the areas of the supports at the connectors.
- Remove the existing paint and rust from the steel components of the supports for the slides at 24 locations. This includes the steel arm and brackets from the foundation piers to the slides.
- Apply a coat of zinc rich primer to the steel supports.
- Apply 2 coats of Sherwin Williams DTM paint to the steel components. Color to be approved by the owner
- Jobsite cleanup.
- Time and materials not to exceed \$29,800.00. This is to be completed per our Maintenance contract rates with Oakland County purchasing
