Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution #1: Award to Low Bidder

Contract 23-08 – Badder Drive Water Main Replacement

History

The 8-inch diameter ductile and cast-iron water main located on the north side of Badder Drive, from Rochester Road to Redwood Park in Sections 34 and 35 is almost 70 years old and has exceeded its service life. This project will replace and upsize this water main to meet current size and fire flow standards while eliminating costly water main brakes which are common with older water mains. Work will include abandoning the 8-inch diameter water main on the above noted drive and installing a new 12-inch diameter water main. Partial pavement reconstruction will also be required. In addition, this project will include the construction of a new 8-inch diameter water main on the south side of Badder Drive which is within the City of Clawson limits. All costs associated with the water main construction within the City of Clawson limits will be reimbursed to the City of Troy in accordance with the Cost Participation Agreement included with this Agenda Item. This work is anticipated to start in March of 2024 and be completed by November 2024.

<u>Purchasing</u>

Bids were received and publicly read on November 29, 2023. The low base bid of \$1,693,397.00 was submitted by Verdeterre Contracting, Inc., 7994 Belleville Road, Belleville, MI 48111 as shown on the attached bid tab. Work was competitively bid and publicly opened with seven (7) bidders responding. The award is contingent upon submission of proper contract and bid documents, including bonds, insurance certificates and all specified requirements.

Financial

Funds for this work are included in the 2023 Water Fund. The budgeted amount includes funds for construction, inspection, testing and contingencies.

Recommendation

It is recommended that City Council award the Badder Drive Water Main Replacement contract to Verdeterre Contracting, Inc., 7994 Belleville Road, Belleville, MI 48111, for their low bid of \$1,693,397.00. In addition, we are requesting authorization to approve additional work, if needed, not to exceed 15% of the original project cost due to unknown conflicts with existing underground utilities and underground conditions that may arise during construction.

Staff also recommends that City Council approve the attached cost participation agreement between the City of Troy and the City of Clawson for the water main construction in the City of Clawson. The Clawson City Council approved the agreement during their regular meeting on November 21, 2023. A copy of the regular meeting minutes and the cost participation agreement document are provided for the Mayor and City Clerk signatures.

This item was submitted to the City Attorney for review pursuant to City Charter Section 3.17.



Badder Drive Water Main Replacement

Dear Mr. Finlay,

Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. (AEW) prepared plans and specifications for the Badder Drive Water Main Replacement Project. This project consists of replacement of water main along Badder Drive between Rochester Road and Key West Drive for the City of Troy water distribution network and includes a new water main loop for the City of Clawson water distribution network.

Attached is a tabulation of bids received by the City of Troy on Wednesday, November 29, 2023 for this project. The base bid is to construct a Class 54 Ductile Iron Water Main and the alternate bid is to construct a C909 PVC Water Main. Seven (7) bids were received for this project, and the low bidder is Verdeterre Contracting, Inc., with a total base bid amount of \$1,693,397.00 and a total alternate bid amount of \$1,598,699.00. Per our conversations, the City would like to proceed with construction of the base bid utilizing ductile iron pipe.

A portion of this project is for work on the City of Clawson water distribution system and will be reimbursed from Clawson. Items included in the general section will be a shared cost between the two cities at an 80%/20% split (80% Troy, 20% Clawson). Specific line items for the Clawson portion of the project will be reimbursed to Troy from Clawson. A cost participation agreement between the two cities has been finalized and approved by the Clawson City Council on November 21, 2023.

Attached is a summary of our conversations with the low bidder's references. Based on these reviews, we recommend that the City of Troy contract with Verdeterre Contracting, Inc., 7994 Belleville Rd, Belleville, MI 48111, for the above referenced project for the base bid amount of \$1,693,397.00.

COST PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

CONSTRUCTION & CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION

Badder Street Rochester Road to Key West Drive In the City of Troy and City of Clawson

	This Agreement, made and entered into this_					day of				, 2023, by and between

WHEREAS, TROY and CLAWSON have programmed the replacement or addition of water main along Badder Drive between Rochester Road and Key West Drive, which improvements involve roads under the jurisdiction of TROY, CLAWSON and the ROAD COMMISSION FOR OAKLAND COUNTY (RCOC), which improvements are hereinafter referred to as the PROJECT; and

WHEREAS the PROJECT costs have been divided between TROY and CLAWSON using the following limitations:

Each City, TROY and CLAWSON, shall pay for materials and work required to complete the improvements associated with each entity's water main distribution system as shown on the plans. The Bid form has been divided by line items and quantities associated with each entity's improvements to reflect this.

TROY's and CLAWSON's share of costs in which cost cannot be easily defined or associated with either entity shall be shared at a portion of 80% and 20%, respectively. These project costs include but are not limited to Mobilization, Construction Administration, Construction Observation and Construction Staking.

After execution of this agreement, TROY will submit an invoice to CLAWSON for its proportionate share of costs incurred and paid to date by TROY on behalf of CLAWSON with regard to this PROJECT. Payment is to be made to TROY within thirty days from receipt of said invoice.

WHEREAS, TROY and CLAWSON have reached a mutual understanding regarding the cost sharing of the PROJECT and wish to commit that understanding to writing in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein and in conformity with applicable law, it is hereby agreed between TROY and CLAWSON that:

1. TROY and CLAWSON approve of the PROJECT, declare its public necessity, and authorize the undertaking and completion of the PROJECT, as above described, including but not limited to all

- construction administration, construction observation and staking and material testing and inspection in reference thereto.
- 2. The actual shared cost of the PROJECT shall include total payments to the contractor, including but not limited to construction administration, construction observation, construction staking, and material testing and inspection costs, if applicable.
- 3. TROY may submit an invoice to CLAWSON, periodically, as additional costs accrue, after TROY has made payments towards the completion of the PROJECT.
- 4. Upon completion of the PROJECT, TROY shall determine the actual total PROJECT cost, and submit an invoice to CLAWSON for any adjustment in the amount of CLAWSON's share of the actual total PROJECT cost, if any.
- 5. Upon receipt of said invoice(s), CLAWSON shall pay to TROY the full amount thereof, within thirty (30) days of such receipt.
- CLAWSON represents and warrants to TROY that they have sufficient funds available to pay its
 obligations under this Agreement and shall pay to TROY all sums due within 30 days of receipt of
 progress invoices.
- 7. Arbitration. Any dispute arising under this agreement will be promptly submitted to and heard and determined by the American Arbitration Association pursuant to its commercial arbitration rules in effect at the time of any dispute. The determination of the arbitrator will be binding on the parties and will not be appealable, and judgment on the award rendered may be entered in any court having jurisdiction on the matter. This agreement is final may only be amended in writing by agreement of the entities.
- 8. Governing Law. This Agreement has been executed and delivered and it shall be interpreted, construed, and enforced under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan. All duties and obligations of the parties created under this Agreement shall be performed in *Oakland* County, Michigan, and under Michigan law. This Agreement was mutually drafted and cannot be construed against either City on the basis that one was the scrivener of the Agreement.
- 9. Assignment. This Agreement may not be assigned unless approved in writing by both parties' consent in writing. This Agreement shall be binding on the parties and their successors in interest.

10. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable for any reason, the

remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. If, because of the invalidity of any

part of this Agreement, either party determines that the purpose and intent of the Agreement has

failed, the parties shall renegotiate in good faith to amend the Agreement to make it valid and

satisfactory to both parties.

11. Articles and Other Headings. The article and other headings in this Agreement are for reference

purposes only and shall not affect in any way the meaning or interpretation of this Agreement.

12. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each

counterpart shall be considered a valid original.

13. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. Neither

party shall be entitled to benefits other than those specified in this Agreement. No oral statements

or prior or contemporaneous written material not specifically incorporated or referenced in this

Agreement shall be of any force and effect, and both parties specifically acknowledge in entering

into and executing this Agreement they rely solely on the representations and agreements contained

in this Agreement.
