Answers: Robert Maleszyk, Chief Financial Officer—The Answers are highlighted in blue. Please also reference the attached spreadsheet for responses to questions 7 and 8.

1.) I see that the retiree healthcare plan contributions are now down to \$1.4 million per year. How have employee healthcare costs and the RHC contributions looked over the last few years? If I recall correctly, weren't RHC contributions almost \$5 million per year a few years ago?

You are correct that contributions have gone down. This is due to our funding levels of the Plan. The Retiree Health Care Plan receives an actuary valuation every two years. The contributions have gone down over the last four valuations to \$5.5 mil, \$3.2 mil, \$2.6 mil, and the most current one dated December 31, 2022, to \$1.4 million.

2.)
I see in the Fire Department expenditures, the entire 1.5 million budgeted for VFIP is considered spent. Is there a fund that the unspent portion of this is now being accounted for?

We plan to designate the unspent portion as an "assigned fund balance" within the general fund.

3.)
How have retirement contributions looked in the last few years? What is the latest on any possibilities with re-opening a pension option for some employees? What is the current funding level of the both Retiree Healthcare and Employee Retirement pension plan?

Contributions for DB Pension have been \$0 since fiscal 2017. Defined contributions cost to the City is between 8 and 12% of salary. Employee contributions to pension are under \$100k. Contributions for RHC are in question #1. Using Investments as of close of business Friday and liability from the audit, we are at 88.5% funded for RHC and 134.1% funded for Pension. Regarding re-opening for some employees: There is no plan to re-open past closed retirement systems. As part of the union negotiation with TPOA, Human Resources, and

Finance are just beginning a project to cost out a defined benefit plan with help from our actuary GRS at the request of the Union.

4.)

What are the Drug Law Enforcement fund expenditures for 803,370?

Primarily the following: Patrol Pistols - \$220,450, Patrol Rifles - \$182,400, Operating Support Vehicle - \$200,000, Rescue Vehicle Upgrade \$45,000, K9 Dog Purchase - \$13,000.

Why does the 2024 police actual vs. police amended budget have a different of 300k? I'm assuming this is due to the Union Contract changes, but can you detail this further?

What is in the 2.7 million in Miscellaneous Other Service Charges under the General Fund?

The \$2.7 million is for the Fire Incentive Plan - \$1.5 mil, Fire Stipend Vol Fire - \$0.4 mil, and the remaining is primarily for Property and Liability Insurance \$0.83 mil.
