Subject: Adoption of the Oakland County Hazard Mitigation Plan

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### **History**

FEMA requires each county to update their hazard mitigation plans every 5 years. In order to be eligible for Federal Hazard Mitigation Grants as authorized under Section 404 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Hazards Mitigation Grant Program, FEMA has mandated that governmental units have in place a comprehensive disaster and hazard mitigation plan. Locally, eligibility for these grants requires adoption of, and participation in, the Oakland County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

The City of Troy participated in the development of the county-wide plan through correspondence with the third-party consulting firm that prepared the document. On December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the Oakland County Board of Commissioners adopted the 2023 Oakland County Hazard Mitigation Plan (Resolution #2023-3506).
