



Snow Removal Services

General Specifications

- 1. Each Contractor shall be responsible for visiting the sites of the proposed work to become fully acquainted with existing conditions, thereby developing a full understanding of any difficulties and restrictions associated with the execution of the proposed contract. The failure or omission to receive and examine any documents, forms, instruments, addendum, or other information, or to visit the site and acquaint oneself with conditions existing there shall in no way relieve any individual or organization from any obligation with respect to the proposal or to the contract. The submission of a proposal shall be taken as prima facie evidence of compliance with this section.
- 2. Contractor employees shall at all times be properly dressed. This attire shall be neat, clean, and well-maintained as follows:
 - a) Pants must be clean and in good repair. Shorts, cutoffs, and sweat pants are not considered proper attire.
 - b) Shirts tee shirts and sleeved work shirts are acceptable if they are clean and in good repair. Tank tops, halter-tops, cut off or ripped shirts, or shirts with objectionable slogans are not acceptable.
 - c) No logos, pictures, commercial advertisements, other than that of the Contractor's shall be exposed while on City Property or in route to the job site.
 - d) Shoes totally enclosed shoes shall be worn at all times. Sandals or similar type of footwear is not acceptable.
- 3. Drivers and operators must safely and legally operate all equipment assigned to them at all times.
- 4. All licenses required by the State of Michigan which are necessary to perform this contract, must be obtained prior to award of contract.
- 5. The Contractor(s) shall at all times observe and comply with all Federal (including E-Verify), State and local laws, ordinances and regulations. The Contractor(s) shall indemnify and hold harmless the City and all its officers, representatives, agents and employees against any claim of liability arising from or based on the violation of any such law, ordinance, or regulation whether by the Contractor(s), it's employees or any subcontractors.
- 6. All snow removal services shall be conducted in a manner that will not create a hazard, nor hinder, restrict or impede traffic. The safety of the Contractor's employees and the public is of prime concern to the City and the Contractor(s) must take all necessary steps to assure proper safety during the performance of this contract.
- 7. Driving Records of Employees: Contractor(s) shall perform a complete driving history search on all employee or pre-approved sub-contractors that will be operating vehicles or equipment. Employees or sub-contractors with an convictions for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI-Intoxicated), Unlawful Blood Alcohol Level (UBAL), Operating While Impaired (OWI), Operating While Under the Influence of a Narcotic or Controlled Substance or the Sale, Use and /or Possession of Marijuana or a Control Substance shall not be allowed to work in Troy at any time. If an employee or pre-approved sub-contractor is arrested or charged with such an offense, Contractor(s) shall immediately stop that employee or sub-contractor from working in Troy. Contractor(s) shall develop a plan/policy for screening criminal and driving records to make sure that all employees and pre-approved sub-contractors are compliant with the terms of the contract. The City shall be provided with a copy of the policy within ten (10) days after the execution of the contract. Contractor(s) shall perform annual Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) checks on all drivers for compliance with the above point convictions and take appropriate action. All of these records are subject to examination by the City.
- 8. <u>Employee Conduct:</u> Contractor(s) will promptly investigate and act upon any allegation that any employee or pre-approved subcontractor has acted in an unprofessional or criminal manner and take the necessary corrective action to remedy the situation.
