The designated City representative retains the right to evaluate the work performed by or on behalf of the successful bidder and reserves the right to reject any work performed that is not in accordance with the specifications or is considered to be poor workmanship. Payment will not be made until the successful bidder has corrected any deficiencies found to the satisfaction of the designated City representative.

PURCHASE ORDER:

After the Troy City Council has approved the award recommendation and acceptable insurance is received, the successful bidder will receive a purchase order issued from the City of Troy, which will create a bilateral contract between the City of Troy and the successful bidder. The purchase order shall commit the bidder to perform the contract in accordance with specifications. A contract document will not be successful.

COMPLETION DATE:

Once the Contractor moves supplies and materials to the work site, work shall commence upon notice to proceed and be completed by <u>November 15, 2021</u>. The City of Troy is the only party to this contract that may authorize amendment to this schedule.

To All Bidders:

Please be advised that the City of Troy Purchasing Department has authorized the following ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS regarding Bid Proposal **ITB-COT 21-43, Holiday Lights.** The CHANGES will be considered an integral part of the original proposal documents.

QUESTION: Are the holiday lights only to be placed on the blue spruce trees? Not the small greenery trees throughout the median?

ANSWER: Yes, the holiday lights are only meant to be placed on the blue spruce trees.

QUESTION: What was the problem(s) with the past Contractor?

ANSWER: The City of Troy is not at liberty to discuss any previous issue with prior contractors. However, this is an annual bid for the City of Troy and is bid out yearly.

QUESTION: Are the lights that were taken down reballed or are they entangled?

ANSWER: The lights are currently bagged and entangled but, will be untangled prior to being released to the awarded contractor.

QUESTION: What spacing would you like on the trees?

ANSWER: 8" - 12" depending on the tree height. At no time should there be more the 40 lights per rectifier.

QUESTION: Does the awarded bidder get paid after installation and/or at what point?

ANSWER: Partial payment will be made at the installation completion. Final payment will be made once lights are removed and returned to the City of Troy.

QUESTION: Also, does the City of Troy supply all materials including commercial grade lights, extension cords and plug adaptors.

ANSWER: The City of Troy will provide all necessary lights, extension cords, and plug adaptors to complete the installation. The installation contractor will be responsible to supply dielectric grease and electrical tape to ensure a weathertight connection.

QUESTION: How tall are the Troy Street light poles?
ANSWER: The receptacles are 8-10' off the ground

QUESTION: Any other info you can provide?

ANSWER:

- It is recommended that the installation is made using a lift to ensure proper coverage and application of the lights. If lights are not properly applied it will be the responsibility of the contractor to return to the site and correct.
- All connections including light strands and extension cords will have an application of dielectric
 grease and be sealed with electrical tape to assist with minimizing moisture in the receptacles and
 plugs.
- The contractor is responsible for all traffic control requirements and devices. No blocking of through lanes of traffic will be permitted. Use of deacceleration lanes is permitted from the indirect left turns.



History

- For two years beginning in 2013, the Kiwanis Club organized the holiday lighting of 25-30 Spruce Trees in the median of Big Beaver in the Troy Downtown Development Authority boundary, which included spaced out locations between Coolidge and Rochester Road.
- In 2016, the City of Troy encouraged the holiday tree lighting and promoted the increase of trees to be decorated.
- The City of Troy decided to install lights on additional trees with lights provided by the Kiwanis and purchase lights and install them on additional trees.
- The goal was to light all Spruce Trees between Rochester Rd. and Coolidge Highway in the Big Beaver median.
- The City of Troy staff continues to receive several compliments on the city's efforts to provide a traditional decorated look for the holiday season along the corridor.
- It is anticipated that the lights will remain on beginning the Monday prior to Thanksgiving through the last day in February.
- The Holiday Lights have an average life span of 3-5 years in the harsh environment they are used.

Purchasing

- On July 22, 2021 a bid opening was conducted as required by the City Charter/Code for one (1) year requirements for the Installation of Holiday Lights.
- The bid was posted on the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN); www.mitn.info.

- Landscape Services, Inc. of Clinton Twp., MI is the low bidder meeting specifications.


