INTENT:

This Addendum #1 is issued to revise the Proposal and answer any contractor questions. The Specifications for the original work and the contract drawings are to govern this work unless otherwise revised herein. **New Proposal Sheets are issued with this Addendum #1 and shall be used in place of existing Proposal Sheets.**

CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS – PROPOSAL

1. Line 090 – REMOVED the quantity listed for the “_Inspection Crew Day” pay item. A quantity shall be provided by the bidder as part of the bids.
2. Lines 054, 072, 077 & 087 – ADDED pay items “Gate Valve, 4 inch”, “_Water Service, DI, CL 54, 4 inch”, “Curb Stop, Curb Box, and Stem (4.0 inch), Complete” and “Water Service Reconnection, Saddle Tap, 4.0 inch” to include the installation of a 4-inch service if necessary.
3. Line 064a – REVISED the line item number
4. Line 067a – REVISED the line item number and added *12-inch* to the description

CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS – WATER SERVICE RECONNECTION

1. ADDED Pay Items #72, 77 & 87 and REVISED the descriptions to the Measurement and Payment section of this specification.

CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS

Question #1: Pay items #70, #79 & #83 are in regard to the 3-inch copper water services. After review of the plans we are unable to location the 3-inch water service on the plans. What is the location of the 3-inch water service? Type K Copper and brass materials (Corp & Curb Stops) are not available in 3-inch size. Also, the manufacturers of Ductile Iron Pipe have discontinued making 3-inch size DI Pipe. If there is a 3-inch water service on the project will the City of Troy accept 4-inch material?

Answer #1: The 3-inch pipe services property 2927 Elliott. We are not sure of the exact location at this time; therefore, it was left off of the plans. The exact location will be determined during construction; however, we still included quantities in the proposal. Based on a quick search, it looks like some suppliers still supply 3-inch Type K Copper. We are adding pay items to the proposal for a 4-inch service in case these 3-inch service and appurtenances are not accessible and a 4-inch is determined to be the best alternate during construction. However, the pay items for the 3-inch service has been left in the contract. The proposal has been updated accordingly.

Question #2: Are Inspection Days for the project a fixed number not to exceed? Normally the days are filled in by the contractor.

Answer #2: This was an error. There is not supposed to be any quantity listed for the Inspection Crew Days. The unit price is set, but the contractor provides the quantity. The proposal has been updated accordingly.

This Addendum #1 has been issued in order to clarify, modify, remove, and add additional items to the original bid package. The Contractor shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by signing in the location provided below and on Page 1 of the Proposal and incorporating this Addendum #1 with the submission of his bid.



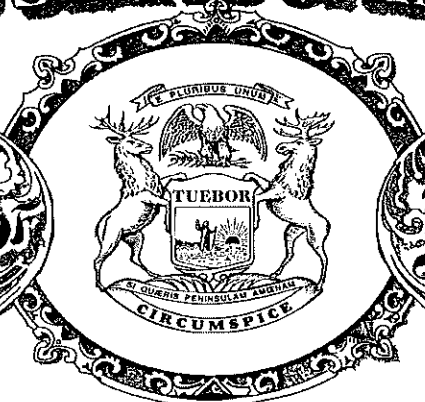
