PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Troy Zoning Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 19, 2021 at 7:30 p.m. The public hearing will be held remotely using the GoToMeeting remote meeting platform. The meeting will not be held in-person due to the COVID-19 pandemic and restrictions placed on public gatherings. The following item will be considered:

Tollbrook North, LLC (“Developer”) appeals the November 10, 2020 decision of the City of Troy’s Planning Commission (“PC”) to deny the Preliminary Site Plan (“PSP”) for its Crooks Road Townhomes project to the City’s Zoning Board of Appeals (“ZBA”).
