PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

A Public Hearing will be held by and before the Council of the City of Troy at City Hall, 500 W. Big Beaver, Troy, Michigan on Monday, April 12, 2021 at 7:30 pm, or as soon thereafter as the agenda will permit, for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Community Development Block Grant Program - that program year 2018 unexpended funds of \$105,082 from Non-Residential Historic Preservation should be re-programmed to the Parks, Recreational Facilities for the continuation of a project started in 2019 to retro fit at Firefighters Park (one of our larger parks) the existing grass pathway to the soccer fields and bleachers with an 8- foot paved asphalt ADA compliant pathway; and install ADA compliant handicapped parking spots with van accessibility, and the proper curb cuts located as close to the pathway as possible. The excess funds were originally reprogrammed to replace the roof on the barn at the Troy Farm.

Currently, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Public Act 254 of 2020 allows for virtual meetings through March 31, 2021.
