A Public Hearing will be held by the Planning Commission of the City of Troy at City Hall, 500 W. Big Beaver, Troy, Michigan, on Tuesday, April 13, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the agenda will permit, to consider a Street Vacation Request to vacate a Public walkway East of John R and North of Big Beaver, abutting 3512 Euclid on the North and 3506 Euclid on the South, Section 24, Currently Zoned R-1C (One Family Residential) District (abutting properties).

The Planning Commission will accept public comments in writing before the public hearing or in person during the public hearing.
